Grantmaking: Frequently Asked Questions

1. What does the HNHfoundation fund?

Applications for funding are considered if they address at least one of the Foundation goals. Check the document, *About the HNHfoundation*, to find our current goals. Applicants may also find it helpful to review archived HNHfoundation *Annual Reports* to learn more about previously funded projects.

2. Is there a deadline for submitting an application?

Grant applications are due on October 15, 2009.

3. Do all applications require a *Letter of Inquiry*?

Yes, due to the limited funds available for new grants in 2009, all applicants must submit a *Letter of Inquiry*.

4. Is there a deadline for submitting *Letter of Inquiry*?

Letters of Inquiry are due August 26, 2009.

5. What is the timeline for grant application review and notification?

Notification of grant award or denial will be made approximately two months following the application due date.

6. How do I know if you received my proposal?

All applicants will receive email confirmation within five working days of application receipt.

7. What are the funding limits for grant applications?

Applicants should request an appropriate amount of funding to meet the needs of their project. Grant applications will be reviewed for, among other criteria, compelling need and a funding request that is reasonable, based on the project description.

8. What types of projects do you fund?

The HNHfoundation funds projects consistent with its mission, vision and goals. Refer to the RFP documents in the Grant center and the *Grantmaking Guidelines*.

9. Who is eligible for HNH*foundation* funding?

Any public or private New Hampshire organization with tax-exempt status is eligible for funding.

10. How do I get an application form?

The *Grant Application* form is posted on the website under the “Grant Center” tab. Other required forms that must accompany the *Grant Application* are also posted here.

11. Do you award multi-year grants?

The HNH*foundation* is not considering multi-year grant requests during the 2009 grant cycle.
